L'Amoureux

ELISHA L'AMOUREUX came from Tarrytown, Westchester County to Rennselaerville, New York, and bought a farm. He was born August 10 1749, and died October 16 1817, and was the third son of Andrew L'Amoureux and his wife Elizabeth.

An Andrew L'Amoureux at one time owned the house and farm at Tarrytown Described by Washington Irving later as the home of Katrina Van Tassel in The Headless Horseman of Sleepy Hollow If this Andrew was the father of Elisha, as seems probable from the dates and the facts known, Elisha must have grown up in surroundings like those in the story. As the father of Miriam Hill owned much land at Red Mills as well as at Lake Maopae, I think that Elisha and Miriam were married before he moved to Rennselaerville.

Ten children were born to them.

Elisha and his wife were very public spirited, and in several ways much Ahead of their time. He had his family inoculated for small pox, and when Any neighbor became ill with it brought him to his house and nursed him Himself. He farm house was one story high with a garret, in which were a hall and two sleeping rooms.

The front porch was very wide, and ran the width of the house: of flag Stones. At the left of the left hand door, (there were two doors) was a Depression in the flagging that formed a sort of basin, worn by the water, in which the men coming into the house from the fields first washed their bare feet.

In April 1939 Harold Dane L'Amoureux of Jamaica Plain in Boston, Massachusetts, published *The Lamoureux Record number two*, a study of the descendants of **André Lamoureux**, shipmaster and pilot of Méché (now Meschers), province of Saintonge, (now Charente Inférieure), France, a Huguenot who with his wife, **Suzanne Latour**, left France for Bristol, England, by 1689, and arrived in New York City by May 1700. The French Church of Bristol (*Publications of the Huguenot Society of London* 20:9) records that on "December 1st 1695, Daniel son of **André Lamoureux**, shipmaster, formally of Méché, in Saintonge, pilot, and of **Suzanne Latour**, his wife, was baptized, born November 29th last."

Mr L'Amoureux continues that this **Daniel**, **André's** only surviving son, left a family record "still preserved, kept in an old account book and written by himself. The handwriting is good but the spelling is what we today would call phonetic..." **Daniel** married **Jeanne Massé**, born 22 May 1696, in New York City, and baptized 5 July 1696 by the reverend Pierre Peiret at New York French Church, a daughter of **Pierre Massé** and **Elizabeth Mercereau**. They lived at New Rochelle about 1725, by 1736 were at Bedford, Westchester County, and by 1739 had apparently settled in what is now Putnam County. His final location was Philipses Precinct, Dutchess County, New York.

Most, but not all, of the genealogically important data from the original family record were printed by Mr L'Amoureux in this pamphlet, but the complete text was not given. In 1961 I wrote him concerning the full record and in April received one of his cheerful and courteous letters telling me:

...I expect your inquiries about Daniel's account book stems from the references to the book on pages six and ten of our Lamoureux pamphlet, in which is mentioned Daniel's "own record now in the possession of Miss Helen DuBarry." Miss DuBarry had a wealth of Lamoureux keepsakes at onetime. What may have become of them I do not know. She was the daughter of General DuBarry and lived at Fort Montgomery, N.Y., for a number of years... Later she was at Annapolis, Md., and Coronado, California ...she wrote...
March 26, 1939: "With the consent of my family I hope to arrange to have

Daniel's book go back to New Rochelle, ...I have not yet decided what I will do with it ...I shall probably leave it to a sister and one of my nephews." ...I do have five typewritten sheets which Miss DuBarry gave to Col. TBL [Thomas Briggs Lamoureux] in 1937...

"In April 1939 Harold Dane L'Amoureux of Jamaica Plain in Boston, Massachusetts, published The LAMOUREUX RECORD number two, a study of the descendents of **André Lamoureux**, shipmaster and pilot of Méché (now Meschers), province of Saintonge (now Charente Inférieure) [this is incorrect or it is Charente-Maritime] France, A Huguenot who with his wife, **Suzanne Latour**, left France for Bristol, England, by 1689, and arrived in New York City by May 1700. The French Church of Bristol (PUBLICATIONS OF THE HUGUENOT SOCIETY OF LONDON 20:9) records that on December 1st 1695, Daniel son of **André Lamoureux**, shipmaster, formally of Méché, in Saintonge, pilot, and of **Suzanne Latour**, his wife, was baptized, born November 29th last.

Mr. L'Amoureux continues that this **Daniel, André's** only surviving son, left a family record "still preserved, kept in an old account book and written by himself. The handwriting is good but the spelling is what we today would call phonetic..." **Daniel** married **Jeane Massé**, born May 22nd 1696, in New York City, and baptized July 5th 1696, at the New York French Church, a daughter of **Pierre Massé** and **Elizabeth Mercereau**. They lived at New Rochelle c. 1725, and by 1736 were at Bedford, Westchester County, and by 1739 had apparently settled in what is now Putnam County. His final location was Philippses Precinct, Dutchess County, New York. [We have found him with a second wife at Tarrytown later.]

Daniel Lamoreaux's hand made account book.

"The handwriting is good but the spelling is ... phonetic. ... not uncommon among even the educated in those days. The accounts and other entries show that he had as good an education as the average man of today, which may be considered a creditable attainment for those times."

"Schools were few, poorly equipped and feebly supported."

Family record written in French "... shows that the French immigrants must have preserved their own language with singular tenacity, and also that their association must have been largely restricted to their own people." "...they (the Lamoureux family) spoke French for nearly 40 years after their arrival in America."

[NOTE: 1720-1739 Daniel Lamoreaux kept his records in French. but wrote his children's names in English, too.]

A letter in possession of Isabelle Lamoreaux Cluff, from Harold Dane L'Amoureux of Boston to David Kendall Martin of West Chazy, NY states:

"Miss Helen DuBarry had a wealth of Lamoureux keepsakes at one time. What may have become of them I do not know. I have some of her correspondence with Judge J.J. Lamoree as early as 1908, also letters between her and A.J. Lamoureux and it was my good fortune to exchange several letters with her myself in 1939. She was the daughter of General DuBarry and lived at Fort Montgomery, NY for a number of years...Later she was at Annapolis, MD, and Coronado, California"

A letter in possession of Isabelle Lamoreaux Cluff, written by Helen DuBarry dated 26 Mar 1939 states:

*"With the consent of my family I hope to Arrange to have **Daniel's** book go back to New Rochelle,...I have not yet decided What I will do with it...I shall probably leave it to a sister and one of my nephews."*

Daniel's book seems to have two pages and a paragraph written by him. The two pages appear to list his marriage to "**Janne**" the birth of his children, ending with an incomplete entry on his last child, **Josué**. His wife which he wrote as "**Jane**," "**Janne**," and "**Jeanne**," seems to have died soon after **Josué** was born.

QUESTIONS

Why page 11, 11½, 12, 13, & 14? Who numbered them? Daniel?

Why does the record start with page 11? Where is page 1, 2, 3, etc.

Why the page 11½? Was this the back of page 11???

Page 12 seems to be started by **Daniel** & ended by his son, Andrew, or his wife Elizabeth???

The first paragraph on page 12 seems to be summaries on **Daniel's** son Andrew & his wife, **Elizabeth**, and his first children, Isaac, John, Elisha & Elizabeth. If these entries were written by **Daniel**, it says a different hand AFTER this entry, **Daniel** seems to have stopped writing between 1751 & 1754. Why only list Andrew's children? Why not Peter & John's too? It seems **Daniel** may have been living with Andrew? OR Andrew inherited the book. **Daniel** was married to Aaltjie Storms Bancker about 1744?

Page 13 seems to be a will or inheritance inventory having to do with Nehemiah & Gabril Traues & Mary Dehus, father & son & daughter, settled by Andrew in 1780. WHY?

Page 14 seems to be written much later. It is the description of the Andrew's family home at Tarrytown, with notes about Washington Irvine. There are also notes on Andrew's third son Elisha.
