

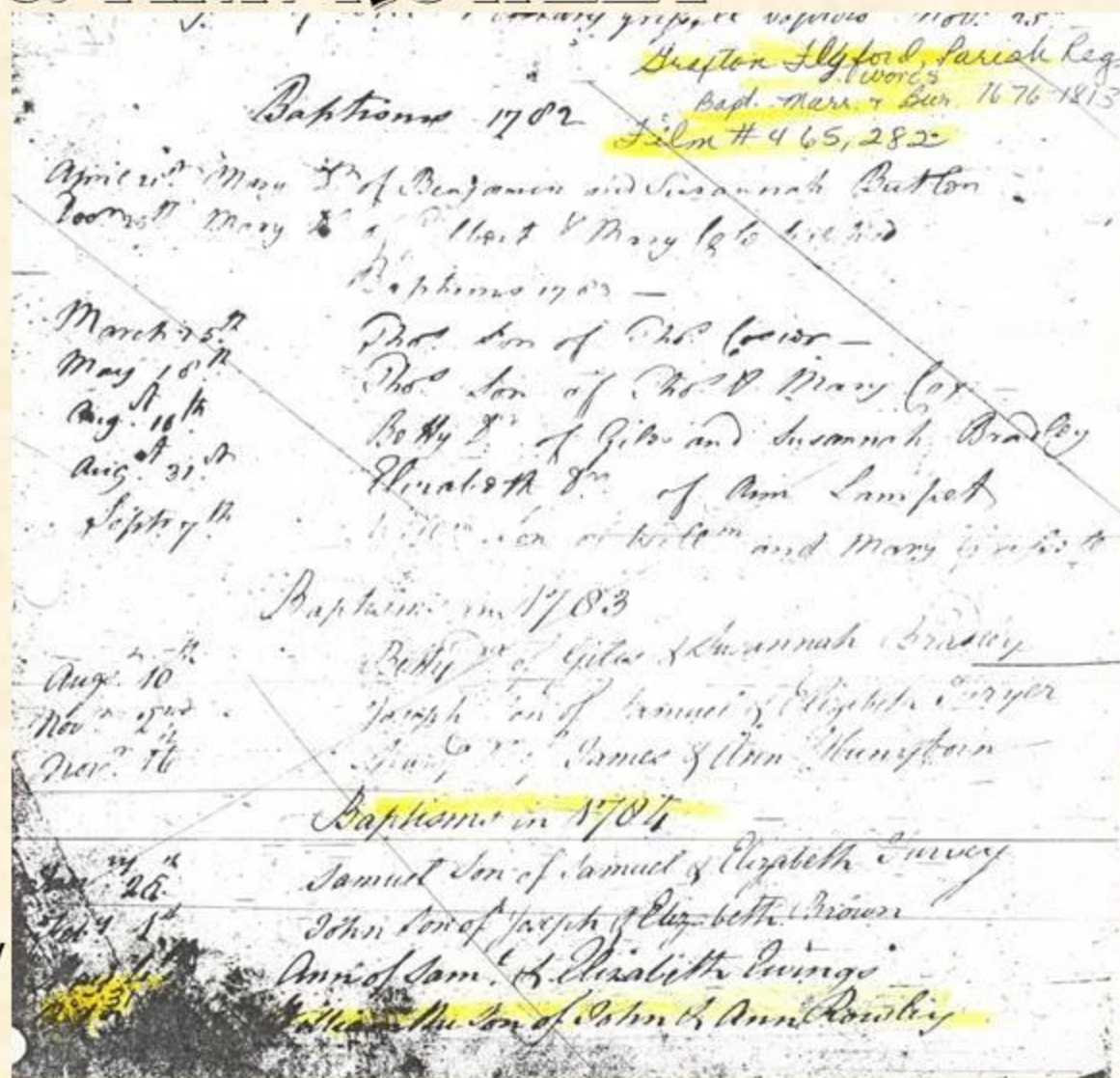

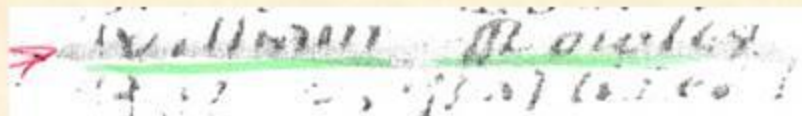
# ANN & WILLIAM are baptized

“Baptized and confirmed May 6, 1840 at Nightengale Bower near Birchwood: **Ann Rowley**”

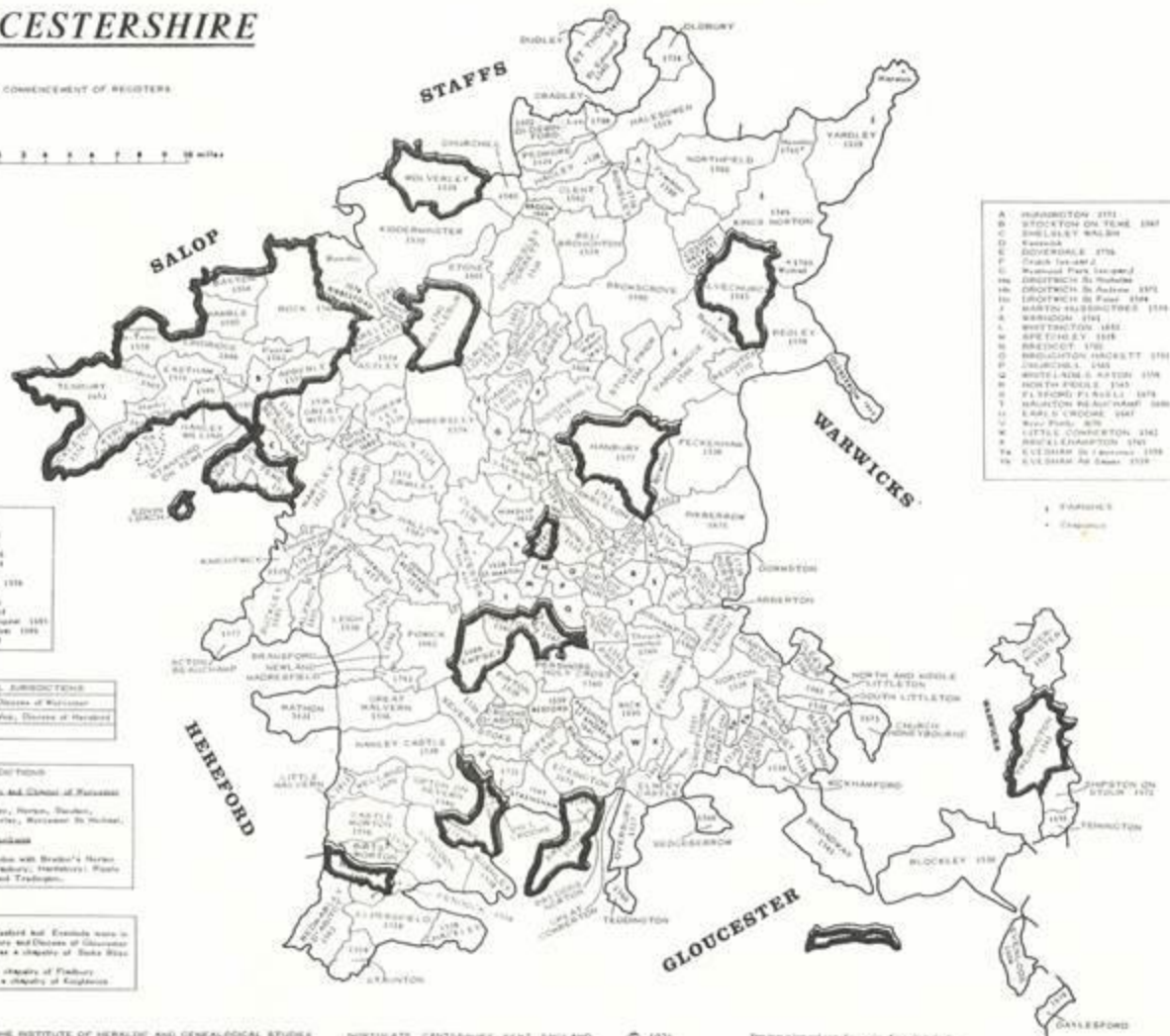


# WORCESTERSHIRE, ENGLAND
